Bracketing: Straight Line Brackets, blind draw, no wrestle-backs, no double bracketing, no staging. Numbered matches, wrestle on same mat. 2 and 3 man brackets may be combined when possible. **NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE AFTER 8:30!**

Coaches meeting at 8:30 am
Wrestling starts at 9:00 am

Rules: Colorado State High School Rules with tournament director's discretion.

Trainer: A trainer will be on location

Attire: Singlets, headgear, covered shoelaces, and mouth pieces (for any wrestler with braces), are **MANDATORY!**

Time Periods: 4, 6 & 8 – Three 60 second periods, 10, 12 & 14 Three 90 second periods

6 and under	Born in 02 or 04- 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 85, hwt
8 and under	Born in 00 or 02 -45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 87, 95, 112, hwt
10 and under	Born in 98 or 00 -55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 100, 105, 112, 120, 130, hwt
12 and under	Born in 96 or 98–65, 70, 77, 84, 91, 98, 105, 112, 120, 128, 136, 144, 152, 160, 175, hwt
14 and under	Born in 94 or 96–77, 84, 91, 98, 105, 112, 119, 125, 130, 135, 140, 145, 152, 160, 171, 189, 215, hwt
