Driving on the Academy

Like any Air Force installation, all vehicles and people are subject to being stopped and searched. Please understand we are trying to balance our need for increased security with the public's desire to visit the Academy.

Seat belts are mandatory!

As of March 1, 2006, privately owned vehicle operators and operators of government vehicles shall not use cell phones unless the vehicle is safely parked or unless they are using a hands-free device.

The safety of motorcyclist operating on Academy grounds is everyone's responsibility. Motorcyclists must wear helmets upon entering Academy grounds and comply with the attached, 'Personal Protective Equipment Requirements for Motorcycle, Motor Scooter and Moped Operations.'
